## **5th Annual Downtown Burbank Car Classic Set to Roar Into Town Saturday, July 30**

**BURBANK, Calif.** — The 5th Downtown Burbank Car Classic will roll into Downtown Burbank with celebrity, custom, and exotic vehicles from the Petersen Automotive Museum, the Television Motion Picture Car Club, Warner Bros. Studio Tour Hollywood, Universal Studios Hollywood, and more on Saturday, July 30 from 3:00 PM to 9:00 PM. In addition, there will be restored cars and hot rods spanning four blocks. DJs spinning tunes, chalk artists, automotive-related vendors, and more than 400 shops and restaurants ready to explore round off activities at this outdoor street festival. The Downtown Burbank Car Classic is free and open to the public.

The Red Carpet Expo, which is dedicated to famous cars from film and television, will feature the Batmobile from the 2016 movie "Batman vs Superman: Dawn of Justice," the Nissan GT-R from the 2015 film "Fast and Furious 7," a 1971 De Tomaso formerly owned by Elvis Presley, a 1946 Ford convertible customized by George Barris from the 1978 movie "Grease," and a 1900 Overland Covered Wagon which was a gift from Bob Hope to John Wayne. Additional participating organizations include Hollywood Hot Rods, Unique Twist, and more.

The Downtown Burbank Car Classic will take place on San Fernando Boulevard from Magnolia Boulevard to Angeleno Avenue. The Red Carpet Expo will be located on San Fernando Boulevard between Olive and Angeleno Avenues, with the Main Stage at San Fernando and Orange Grove Avenue.
