**BURBANK BEER FESTIVAL TO RETURN  
TO DOWNTOWN BURBANK OCTOBER 21  
Festival to Introduce Three Tasting Blocks,  
Expand Musical Offerings**

**BURBANK, Calif.** — Downtown Burbank is pleased to announce more than 85 craft beers on tap, a fall street fair, and a host of live entertainment at the 3rd Annual Burbank Beer Festival happening on Saturday, October 21 from 12 noon to 7:30 PM.

The Burbank Beer Festival will take over five blocks of Downtown Burbank with two sessions of craft beer sampling. Session 1 will be from 12:00 PM to 3:00 PM, with Session 2 from 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM. A complimentary shuttle will connect festival-goers with Burbank hotels. Attendees who book their hotel via [www.visitburbank.com](http://www.visitburbank.com) will receive two free tickets to the festival, an \$80 value.

In addition to the two ticketed sampling sessions, the Burbank Beer Festival will include a free street fair with a variety of vendors that will be open to all. DJs and performers will provide entertainment with live musical performances taking place on the main stage located at San Fernando Boulevard and Olive Avenue. Performers include the genre-defying four-piece band [Rey Fresco](#), R&B Latin band [Adelaide](#), and [DJ Cue](#).

The festival is also a great opportunity to experience Downtown Burbank's 400 shops and restaurants, such as the recently opened The Boiling Crab, Chronic Tacos, and Yard House. Fall Street Fair hours will be from from 12:00 noon to 7:30 PM, and entry is free and open to the public. Tickets for the beer tasting are [\\$40-\\$45](#), and include a tasting glass and 3-ounce craft beer samples from more than 45 breweries, at 3 tasting stations. Individuals must be 21 years of age or older with a valid ID to enter the festival's beer tasting blocks and to consume alcohol. Tickets will also be sold at the door while supplies last. Entry to the street fair portion of the event is free of charge.
